# Book Presentation Smart Mobility

This volume relates the experience of the first year of UniWeLab, a research workshop born from the union of goals of University of Genoa and WeBuild. A collaboration for the development of innovative ideas in the sustainable mobility sector, to produce value for the territory. The objective of the laboratory is to investigate all the phenomena that can make an infrastructure sustainable in all its aspects: social, economic and environmental and, subsequently, apply the experience acquired to the Genoa cases. UniWeLab faces up to the Sopraelevata, a symbol of Genoa; what will its future be if the traffic is diverted through the sub-port tunnel that connects San Benigno to Calata Gadda? Fifteen students are studying whether it is possible and how to transform it, projecting it into the future. Enrico Musso and Ilaria Delponte are the editors of a collection of unpublished and proactive experiences and projects for the city of Genoa.
